Split decision

When Proctor & Shaw (020 8244 6110; proctorandshaw.com) renovated a central London apartment, its concrete structural framework enabled the company to remove non-load-bearing walls to reconfigure the layout. A full-height grooved timber partition wall, made from Douglas fir battens, now runs lengthways to divide the space into a living area, with two bedrooms on the other side, reached through frameless doors. >>
